Sylvia is a master gardener and wanted a plant that would represent hope for people living with MS, people like her daughter, Carol. She spoke with a national nursery and found out that naming a rose could take up to 3 years and cost \$20,000! A fellow master gardener suggested that Sylvia contact Pat Henry at Roses Unlimited in Laurens, South Carolina. After a little research and a few phone calls, Pat located a supplier in California who was willing to name a miniature rose plant the MS Hope Rose. Pat propagated 1,000 plants in her nursery and sold most of them at the Bike MS event in Greenville, South Carolina.

The MS Hope Rose is a vibrant miniature rose that symbolizes MS Awareness and brings warmth and joy into the garden. It is 24" – 30" high and about 2' wide. This plant is a great addition to the garden and thrives well in decorative pots. The cost of the rose is \$10 with \$2 going to benefit the Alabama Chapter of the National MS Society. Shipping cost is \$10 for up to 10 plants.
